## Why a Masjid?

The number of Muslims in the Bracknell area has increased from over 2500 as per the 2010 census and is still increasing. A dedicated place to practice and share our faith is really important. However, the Muslim community in Bracknell is facing many issues due to the lack of permanent place of worship. The Masjid will also serve as community centre and will play additional roles in:

- ✓ **Education:** Early childhood and youth development, skill classes (Quran, fiqh ethical and moral oriented activities)
- ✓ **Social welfare:** Religious events, matrimonial, mediation, charity, funeral services, and general enquiries.



## Project's Phases

BICS committee considered and approved three phases for the development project. The project is welcomed and has been fully endorsed by the local authority of Bracknell Forest Council. The fundraising progress is updated regularly online and during every Jumaah prayer.



### Phase 01

Find and acquire a suitable land to build the Masjid or purchase an existing property  
Target to acquire a Land is: **£800,000**



### Phase 02

Construction of the Masjid or refurbishment of an existing structure.



### Phase 03

Maintenance of the building and introduction of new services.
